Illinois Reform Commission Names Commissioners

The Illinois Reform Commission, headed by former Assistant U.S. Attorney Patrick Collins, is naming 14 community leaders as commissioners of the independent advisory panel. Additional members will be named in the near future.

Lt. Gov Quinn signed an executive order creating the Commission which will conduct an examination of government practices and ethics. Upon conclusion, the Commission will make recommendations for cleaning up state government.
